WHO MAY APPLY TO THIS ANNOUNCEMENT:

- Career or career conditional employees, Veteran's Canteen Service and permanent Title 38 employees of the Portland VA Medical Center eligible under the interchange Agreement.
- Any US Citizen

MAJOR DUTIES:

The Portland VA Medical Center now accepts applications on a continuous basis for all specialties and locations LPN's are employed. You are encouraged to contact the Office of Nursing Professional Services to submit an application for employment. Applications are forwarded for 6 months to all hiring managers in the specialty areas you indicate in the application materials. Opportunities for Nursing employment at PVAMC's occur often and we invite you review the excellent benefits our LPN's enjoy. PVAMC is one of the five Magnet Designated VA Hospitals in the country. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Experience: 1 year LPN experience required or clinical rotation at the Portland VA Medical Center within the past 12 months.

Eligibility: Department of Veterans Affairs Qualifications Standards (VA Handbook 5005, Part II, Appendix G6) applies and may be reviewed in the Human Resources Management Service Office.

A. Must be a U.S. citizen.

- B. Full active, current and unrestricted licensure as a graduate licensed practical or vocational nurse in a state, territory or commonwealth (i.e., Puerto Rico) of the United States or District of Columbia.
- C. Graduate of a school of practical or vocational nursing approved by the appropriate State accrediting agency and/or the National League of Nursing at the time the program was completed by the applicant. Health care education in the military service or training in the military service which is accepted by the licensing body in the jurisdiction in which the individual is licensed as qualifying for full LPN/LVN licensure will be accepted as meeting the education requirements for VHA employment.
- D. Licensed practical or vocational nurses appointed to direct patient care positions must be proficient in (both) spoken and written English as required by 38 USC 7402(d), and 7407(d).

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- It may be necessary to utilize the selected person's services at a different location than hired within the Portland VA Medical Center commuting area including Washington and Oregon if conditions require it in the future.
- Under Executive Order 11935, only United States citizens and nationals (residents of American Samoa and Swains Island) may compete for civil service jobs. Agencies are permitted to hire noncitizens only in very limited circumstances where there are no qualified citizens available for the position.
- All applicants must submit their credentials and work history in VetPro as part of the application process If you are a male born after December 31, 1959, and are at least 18 years of age, civil service employment law (5 U.S.C. 3328) requires that you must register with the Selective Service System, unless you meet certain exemptions.
- A security clearance and a favorable suitability determination are required. Misconduct in prior employment, criminal, dishonest or disgraceful conduct, habitual use of intoxicating beverages, abuse of narcotics, drugs or other

controlled substances, or reasonable doubt of loyalty to the United States are examples of reasons an offer of employment may be denied.

- Public transit subsidy benefits are available. Carpooling assistance is provided. However, single occupancy parking is limited on main Portland campus.
- A drug test may be required for an applicant who is tentatively selected.
- A pre-employment physical examination will be required for an applicant who is tentatively selected.
- <u>VACareers</u> has descriptions of all Title 38 Jobs and their benefits.
- This agency provides reasonable accommodations to applicants with disabilities. If you need a reasonable accommodation for any part of the application and hiring process, please notify the agency. The decision on granting reasonable accommodation will be on a case-by-case basis

APPLICANT'S PLEASE NOTE:

- Education must be accredited by an accrediting institution recognized by the U.S. Department of Education in order for it to be credited towards qualifications (particularly positions with a positive education requirement.).
