WHO MAY APPLY TO THIS ANNOUNCEMENT:

- Career or career conditional employees and permanent Title 38 employees of the Portland VA Medical Center eligible under the interchange Agreement. Included are permanent employees of the Willamette National Cemetery, Regional Office, Veterans Outreach Center and Veteran's Canteen.
- Any US Citizen

***MAJOR DUTIES:**

The incumbent will examine, diagnose, treat, and manage diseases and disorders of the visual system, the eye and associated structures, as well as diagnosis related systemic conditions. Credentialed and clinically privileged optometrists are responsible for the care of all patients examined by optometric trainees. The staff optometrist will comply with the requirements for resident supervision as outlined in the Veterans Health Administration Manual M-2, Part I, Chapter 26. Close supervision is required for fourth professional year students participating in clinical rotations at the Portland VA Medical Center (PVAMC) from affiliated schools and college of optometry. The optometry staff or residents must have direct contact with each patient evaluated by these trainees. The staff optometrist's clinic work site will be Bend CBOC. Bedside consultations for inpatients will be provided on an as needed basis. Candidates who have completed residency training and/or have prior experience as staff optometrists within the Department of Veterans Affairs will be given highest consideration for appointment as staff optometrist at PVAMC. Prior experience as a clinical educator is also highly desirable. Incumbent is accountable to the Chief of the Optometry Section as well as patients, customers, and team members in the care of the veteran.

***QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

Eligibility: VA Handbook 5005, Pt II, Appendix G5 for VP-662 series applies and may be reviewed in the Human Resources Management Service office.

Basic Requirements:

- Must be a citizen of the United States.
- Must have a degree of doctor of optometry resulting from a course of education in optometry. The degree must have been obtained from one of the schools or colleges approved by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs for the year in which the course of study was completed.
- Must be licensed to practice optometry in a State, Territory, or Commonwealth of the United States, or in the District of Columbia. Optometrists are required to possess full and unrestricted licensure and to maintain a current registration in their State of licensure if this is a requirement of the particular State.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Although the duty station is shown in this announcement, it may be necessary to utilize the selected person's services at a different location within the Portland VA Medical Center commuting area if conditions require it in the future

Under Executive Order 11935, only United States citizens and nationals (residents of American Samoa and Swains Island) may compete for civil service jobs. Agencies are permitted to hire noncitizens only in very limited circumstances where there are no qualified citizens available for the position.

All information submitted to this VA Medical Center is subject to verification by VetPro.

If you are a male born after December 31, 1959, and are at least 18 years of age, civil service employment law (5 U.S.C. 3328) requires that you must register with the Selective Service System, unless you meet certain exemptions.

A security clearance and a favorable suitability determination are required. Misconduct in prior employment, criminal, dishonest or disgraceful conduct, habitual use of intoxicating beverages, abuse of narcotics, drugs or other controlled substances, or reasonable doubt of loyalty to the United States are examples of reasons an offer of employment may be denied.

Public transit subsidy benefits are available. Carpooling assistance is provided. However, single occupancy parking is limited on

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main Portland campus.

Eligible employees may be non-competitively reassigned to fill this position as an exception to merit promotion.

The applicant selected for this position will be eligible to apply for an education loan reimbursement award under the provisions of the Education Debt Reduction Program (EDRP).

A drug test may be required for an applicant who is tentatively selected.
