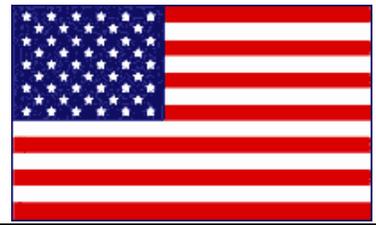

### WHO MAY APPLY TO THIS ANNOUNCEMENT:

- Career or career conditional employees and permanent Title 38 employees and permanent Title 38 Hybrid employees of the Portland VA Medical Center eligible under the interchange Agreement. Included are permanent employees of the Willamette National Cemetery, Regional Office, Veterans Outreach Center and Veteran's Canteen.
- Career or career conditional employees and permanent Title 38 employees of other VA facilities.
- Applicants with competitive status outside the VA i.e., those with transfer or reinstatement eligibility.
- Veterans who are preference eligibles or who have been separated from the armed forces under honorable conditions after 3 or more years of continuous active service.
- Employees covered under the provision of the inter-agency Career Transition Plan (ICTAP) and Career Transition Assistance Plan (CTAP) (displaced VA Employees) eligibles will be given priority consideration for vacancies within the **local commuting area** for which they are well qualified. Applicants requesting this consideration must attach appropriate proof of the ICTAP eligibility with their application.

### MAJOR DUTIES:

Incumbent serves as Program Support Assistant for the Advanced Low Vision Clinic at the Portland VA Medical Center. The incumbent will function with substantial independence and will act as the lead point of contact for low vision specialty administrative issues. Incumbent acts as a subject matter expert and trainer of other non-clinical staff by fulfilling all processing requirements for the Advanced Low Vision specialty clinic. Incumbent is considered a subject matter expert, and is primarily responsible for assisting the clinical team by facilitating the administrative needs of patients receiving low vision services. The secondary focus will be staff and management of the daily office operations of the Advanced Low Vision Clinic. Incumbent facilitates team processes by working in collaboration with team members or employees to ensure that tasks are completed, that good working relationships exist among team members and management, and that team priorities and goals, needs and achievements are coordinated with management. Incumbent communicates and coordinates with the Program Clinical Directors and Administrative Manager, VIST Coordinator, BROS, and various staff, housestaff, and administrators at PVAMC, VA medical centers nationwide and VACO. S/he provides knowledge of programs, policies, resources and processing requirements to the Advanced Low Vision Clinic at the PVAMC. S/he serves as a multiskilled person dedicated to patient care management by identifying patient issues and problems in both the inpatient and outpatient settings. Incumbent acts as the clinic matrix expert and offers instruction, guidance and support for all low vision clinic matrixes and their changes. S/he schedules tests and procedures, makes recommendations to improve patient flow and administrative efficiency, effectively resolving issues related to patient care at the program level.

### **THIS POSITION IS IN THE BARGAINING UNIT**

### QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

**Eligibility:** U.S. Office of Personnel Management Qualification Standards Handbook for GS-303 series applies and may be reviewed in the Human Resources Management Service office. Regulatory requirements such as "time-in-grade" and "time after competitive appointment" are applicable.

**Specialized Experience:** One (1) year experience that equipped the applicant with the particular knowledge, skills, and abilities (KSA's) to perform successfully the duties of the position, and that is typically in or related to the work of the position to be filled. To be creditable, specialized experience must have been equivalent to at least the next lower grade level.

**Substitution of Education for Experience:** As a general rule, education is not creditable above GS-5 for most positions

covered by this standard; however, graduate education may be credited in those few instances where the graduate education is directly related to the work of the position.

### **BASIS OF RATING: (Knowledge, Skills, Abilities (KSAs))**

***On a separate sheet of paper, provide a written, detailed response to each of the KSAs. Failure to respond to rating factors will result in applicant not being referred for the position:***

1. Ability to work independently for long periods of time with little or no supervision, and also function as part of the eye care team.
2. Ability to multi-task several functions and effectively prioritize those functions within multiple deadlines.
3. Ability to schedule patients for multiple services and coordinate medical appointments.
4. Demonstrated ability to use tact and diplomacy when dealing with all customers and co-workers, including skill in providing customer service. This includes the ability to effectively triage telephone calls from blind rehab staff, medical staff, patients and their families/caregivers, ability to order specific prosthetics equipment as requested, and ability to support staff with orders and scheduling issues.
5. Knowledge of computer programs as they relate to the position including Vista database, Microsoft Excel database, CPRS, and the blind rehabilitation database

### **CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:**

Although the duty station is shown in this announcement, it may be necessary to utilize the selected person's services at a different location within the Portland VA Medical Center commuting area if conditions require it in the future. Applicants without prior federal service will be appointed at step one of the grade.

Eligible employees may be non-competitively reassigned to fill this position as an exception to merit promotion.

Under Executive Order 11935, only United States citizens and nationals (residents of American Samoa and Swains Island) may compete for civil service jobs. Agencies are permitted to hire noncitizens only in very limited circumstances where there are no qualified citizens available for the position.

If you are a male born after December 31, 1959, and are at least 18 years of age, civil service employment law (5 U.S.C. 3328) requires that you must register with the Selective Service System, unless you meet certain exemptions.

A security clearance and a favorable suitability determination are required. Misconduct in prior employment, criminal, dishonest or disgraceful conduct, habitual use of intoxicating beverages, abuse of narcotics, drugs or other controlled substances, or reasonable doubt of loyalty to the United States are examples of reasons an offer of employment may be denied.

Public transit subsidy benefits are available. Carpooling assistance is provided. However, single occupancy parking is limited on main Portland campus.

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This agency provides reasonable accommodations to applicants with disabilities. If you need a reasonable accommodation for any part of the application and hiring process, please notify the agency. The decision on granting reasonable accommodation will be on a case-by-case basis.
