Frank Marré DO, MS, FAOCOPM was appointed VISN 20's Chief Medical Officer on October 1, 2007. In this position, Dr. Marré is responsible for the oversight of all clinical services within the VISN.

Prior to his appointment, Dr. Marré served as the Associate Vice President for Clinical Programs, Spectrum Health/Priority Health, Grand Rapids, MI. Spectrum Health is a large integrated delivery system including 7 hospitals, several physician groups and a health plan, Priority Health. There he was responsible for wellness, preventive medicine, chronic disease management, clinical pharmacy, credentialing, accreditation and clinical analytics. During his tenure, performance dramatically improved, resulting in national recognition and awards for a variety of clinical programs such as asthma and diabetes management, preventive medicine and pay for performance.

Dr. Marré also served as District Medical Director at Group Health Cooperative, Seattle, Washington, Medical Director for Medical Affairs at St. John's Medical Center and Visiting Medical Director for Quality at Dartmouth Hitchcock Medical Center. In total, he has over eighteen years experience as a senior executive. Dr. Marré is data driven, while at the same time sees the value in building interdisciplinary leadership teams.
